KNOW YOUR RIGHTS!

DOES THIS FIT YOU...

- NOT LIVING WITH A PARENT OR A LEGAL GUARDIAN
- LIVING "DOUBLED-UP" WITH FRIENDS OR RELATIVES
- LIVING IN A MOTEL/VEHICLE/CAMPGROUND
- LIVING IN AN EMERGENCY OR TRANSITIONAL SHELTER
- LIVING IN AN ABANDONED BUILDING, RAILER OR OTHER PLACES WHERE PEOPLE SHOULD NOT BE SLEEPING

IF THIS FITS, YOU, OR ONE OF YOUR FRIENDS, CONTACT A TRUSTED ADULT IN THE SCHOOL OR THE DISTRICT ITINERATE COUNSELOR OR A SOCIAL SERVICES MANAGER.

...IF YES, THEN READ THIS*:

- You have the right to enroll in school immediately, even if you do not have a permanent address, school records, medical records or signature of a parent or legal guardian.
- You have the right to stay in your current school (school of origin) even if you move, OR you may enroll in the local attendance area school where you are currently living, if that is your choice and is your best interest, OR you may attend the school in which you were last enrolled.
- If you disagree with the school's enrollment decision, the school must provide you with a written explanation, and you have the right to appeal the decision. You have the right to enroll in your chosen school while the dispute is being resolved.
- You have the right to transportation assistance to your school of origin.
- You have the right to receive educational services comparable to those provided to other students according to your needs, including participation in extracurricular activities (sports, music, etc.)
- You have the right to receive McKinney-Vento support services such as: free school meals, school supplies, fee waivers, academic assistance, support for making post high school college/career plans, and verification as an independent student on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), and referrals to community resources

Your school district's McKinney-Vento contact person is the Itinerant Counselor and is available to assist you with stability and support in school.
